A free service to help lung cancer patients, survivors, and their loved ones identify appropriate clinical trials.

Clinical trials are vital to evaluating new treatments for lung cancer. Lung Cancer Alliance is dedicated to making the process of learning about and joining trials as easy and understandable as possible. We are able to do so through our partnership with EmergingMed.

EmergingMed's mission is to create a coordinated, seamless connection between patients, clinical trials, and physicians at exactly the right time. EmergingMed's database only includes trials with understandable language and user-friendly contact information.

The *Lung Cancer Clinical Trial Matching Service* is:

- **Convenient.** The service can be accessed online via Lung Cancer Alliance's website (www.lungcanceralliance.org) or through the toll-free line, 1 (800) 698-0931. Appropriate trial information can be sent via mail or e-mail for discussion with the treatment team.
- **Personalized.** Appropriate trials are identified by matching the person's specific diagnosis, stage, and treatment history.
- **Professional.** Callers to the toll-free line speak with specialists who identify appropriate clinical trials as well as educate about the trial process.
- **Confidential.** Safeguarding personal information, whether online or by phone, is of utmost importance.
